THE RESULT

The central plant cooling tower for the G, N, and P buildings was done to service the efforts of Algonquin College's participation in the Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program (GHGRP). The program collects information on greenhouse gas emissions annually from facilities across Canada. The GHGRP helps assess Canada's overall environmental performance in various ways:

- It supports accurate tracking of GHG emissions
- It contributes to policies and strategies related to climate change, industrial activities and energy use
- It provides a consistent, more precise picture of the issue, and contributes to solutions
